「腦友導航」手機應用程式發布會

香港大學顧問團隊於2015年推算,隨着本港老年人口不斷上升,本港至2019年將有七萬七千名七十歲或以上,居於社區的確診認知障礙症患者。東華三院社會服務科東區及中西區區域辦事處因應認知障礙症的常見癥狀,包括認路困難、迷路走失、善忘等,開發了一款名為「腦友導航」的手機應用程式,期望透過當中的支援功能,幫助護老者更適切地照顧家中長者。

「腦友導航」手機程式發布會於11月15日舉行,大會邀得高錕慈善基金董事局主席高黃美芸女士及社會福利署東區及灣仔區助理福利專員薛詠蓮女士主持啟動禮。「腦友導航」是本院首個針對認知障礙症而設計的應用程式,程式集多項功能於一身,包括定位追蹤、服藥提示、尋人等。當中的「認識.我」功能,可儲存長者的資料,例如喜愛的稱號、食物、嗜好等,方便照顧者更加了解長者的需要,加強溝通。

為進一步提升業界同工回應患者行為轉變的能力,以及支援照顧者的專業知識和技巧,大會當日邀請了香港精神科醫學院發言人趙少寧醫生提供專題培訓,共有一百六十位嘉賓及業界同工出席。

TWGHs Introduced CHEERS Mobile App


One of TWGHs' goals has been to provide better support for elders with dementia and their caregivers. In line with this, the Community Service Division Eastern/Central and Western District Office introduced the mobile app CHEERS on 15 November 2016. Mrs. KAO May Wan, Gwen, Chairman of the Charles K Kao Foundation for Alzheimer's Disease, and Ms. SIT Wing Lin, Assistant District Social Welfare Officer (Eastern/

Wan Chai) of the Social Welfare Department, were invited to officiate at the Launching Ceremony.

CHEERS is the first mobile application developed by TWGHs to help ease the lives of people with dementia and their care givers. Some of the app's functions include a GPS locator, a medication reminder and search for missing demented persons. Another function called "This is ME" is designed to help caregivers better understand elderly people that suffer from dementia.

A staff training for professional caregivers working with dementia patients

was held on the same day. Dr. CHIU Siu Ning, spokesperson of The Hong Kong College of Psychiatrists, hosted the session, which was attended by 160 guests and caregivers.
