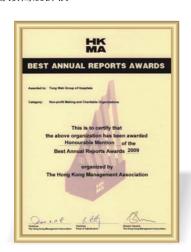
組織

主要工作

拓展傳媒網絡

本處致力開拓傳媒網絡,讓廣大市民認識本院的服務,其中包括爲「上醫館」九型體質辨識舉行傳媒聚會;另爲有關發展四年制學士學位課程計劃、電子書、遠程教學活動、麵包工房社會企業、預防青少年吸毒成癮服務,及善長行善的感人故事增加媒體報導。

妥善處理申訴及危機

提供高素質機構資訊

本處負責機構對外發放資訊的刊物、 錄像製作及電子網站設計,包括撰寫 《東華通訊》的每月專題文章、統整 及編輯各部門工作報告製成年報、攝 製環保教育活動的錄像光碟、設計網 站專頁、管理機構網站及Facebook專 頁資訊等,在提升機構透明度的同時 亦致力確保持份者和公衆得到高素質 的資訊。

推動環保教育及宣傳工作

為迎接本院開展「東華三院邁向綠色機構」三年計劃帶來的挑戰,本處擔任環保工作小組的成員,負責籌劃及推進環保教育及宣傳的具體工作,以期東華在實施環保試點項目的同時能為本院廣大的服務使用者和員工廣泛發送環保訊息,以凝聚力量提升本院履行企業責任的成效。

The Branch held a media gathering for TWGHs Wilson T.S. Wang Centre of Integrated Health Management to publicize its body constitution service.

Objectives

The Corporate Communications Branch aims at generating public empathy and support of the Group's initiatives for its long-term and sustainable development. This is achieved through formulating and implementing corporate communications strategies in media networking, publications production, event management, web content management and design management.

Organization

The four-member Corporate Communications Branch was set up in November 2009 and is responsible for the planning, management and implementation of corporate communications work under the guidance of the Board of Directors.

Award

Honourable Mentions in Hong Kong Management Association Best Annual Report Awards

The Group's 2008/2009 Annual Report won the Honourable Mentions in the "Non-profit Making and Charitable Organizations" category of the Hong Kong Management Association Best Annual Reports Awards. The panel was impressed with the detailed and accurate reporting on the Group's corporate governance, employee relations and corporate social responsibilities.

Major Tasks

Media networking

The Branch works with the media to publicize the Group's services. There was media coverage on the Chinese and western medicine integrated health management concept, the development plan of 4-year degree programmes, introduction of electronic textbooks, distance learning and teaching activities, bakery social enterprise, anti-drug services for the youths as well as the stories of donors, among others.

Management of complaints and crisis

Working jointly with other Divisions and Branches, responses to media inquiries and complaints from the public have been expedited with prompt incident investigation. A review on the workflow of complaints processing is underway with the Audit Branch, which will lead to the setting up of an open and fair mechanism for complaints handling, thereby ensuring service quality to meet public expectation. Besides, the Branch was responsible for issuing flash reports to update the Board on the latest situation of crisis or incident, and to recommend remedial actions as necessary. With such good practices in place, timely and accurate information has been disseminated to the public.

Corporate information management

With the objectives to enhance the Group's transparency as well as providing accurate information to stakeholders and the public, the Branch took charge of the dissemination of information through managing the quality and timeliness of printed publications, audio/visual materials and website. Activities included editing and writing stories in the monthly Tung Wah News, compiling and editing work reports from other Divisions and Branches for producing the Annual Report, producing video on Green education programmes, designing web pages for special projects, content management of the official website and the Facebook Page.

Promoting Green education and Green projects

To meet the challenge in the launching of the "TWGHs Moving Towards a Green Organization" 3-year programme, besides being a member of the Green Working Group, the Branch was responsible for the planning and implementation of Green education and publicity work to engage service users and staff and empower them to sustain the Group's Green efforts, which also highlighted the Group's initiative in fulfilling social responsibility.

As a Green organization, Tung Wah has developed a website [www.tungwah.org.hk/green] and organized a series of Green learning programmes jointly with colleagues from education and community services. Activities such as the fun-filled Kick-off Ceremony for the Little Green Angel - Green Education for Young Children, the Facebook Green Tips Competitions, the Joint Schools Green Mascot and Slogan Design Competition, and the Joint Schools Seminar on Building a Green Hong Kong have reached out to more than 30,000 students and their families from the community college, secondary schools, primary schools, special schools, kindergartens and nursery schools under the Group. These activities have enhanced the students' sense of environmental conservation and green living, and helped sustain the momentum of the Group's campaign. Commemorative activities of 140th Anniversary

To mark the 140th anniversary of the Group on 30 March 2010, the Board has endorsed the production of our first movie, "Merry-Go-Round", to convey to the general public, especially the younger generation, our core values and the need to think positive in face of adversity. The anniversary reception and movie premiere were held on 26 March 2010 at the Pacific Place, Queensway, also starting a 5-day exhibition on the history of Tung Wah.

Taking the opportunity, projects from our medical, education and community services, in addition to highlight activities on our heritage conservation efforts and Green initiatives, were organized in 2009/2010 through to the coming year. Aside from the opening ceremony, the Branch was the coordinator in promoting all the anniversary projects, including the Tung Wah Movie "Merry-Go-Round", the newly launched history books, a joint exhibition with the Hong Kong Museum of History, among others. The Branch also coordinated efforts to enhance the anniversary promotion through design management of the anniversary logo in publicity materials and stationary items, publishing anniversary brochure and newspaper supplement, and promotion of key events of other Divisions and Branches throughout the anniversary year.
