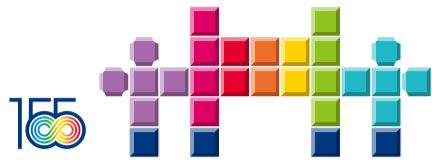




## 主席感言 CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

本院各項服務及活動持續推進，時刻關顧香港人的服務需要。適逢創院155周年，由特區政府房屋局資助、本院興建及營運的第三個過渡性房屋項目「流浮·東寓」，誠蒙房屋局局長何永賢太平紳士主禮，本月圓滿舉行入伙祈福典禮。該項目配套完善，環境清雅寧靜，欣見居民陸續遷入，開展安穩新生活，令人倍感欣慰。我亦感謝何永賢局長撥冗出席了由元朗攸望路簡約公屋與中華電力有限公司合辦的「全電家居·幸福攸此起」冬至嘉年華暨盆菜宴，與居民共迎新歲。當日社區廚神決賽競爭激烈，見證街坊廚神的誕生，充分展現社區共融的和樂景象，為節日增添溫馨氣氛。

本院一直與特區政府攜手，協力推動多元化的社會服務。本月，感謝教育局局長蔡若蓮博士太平紳士聯同共創明「TEEN」校友會義工，以及由食物環境衛生署署長吳文傑太平紳士帶領義工隊，分別到訪東華三院小欖峻庭和東華三院賽馬會頤樂護理安老院，於新春之際與院友們互動交流，送上關懷和溫暖。

為促進教職員的專業成長，本院舉辦聯校專業發展日，以「AI賦能教學與專業領導：未來教育的藍圖」為主題，為逾二千名教職員提供專業培訓，欣蒙教育局副局長施俊輝博士太平紳士擔任主禮嘉賓，多位教授分享專業見解，將助教職員為教學注入新思維。此外，本院積極搭建多元舞台，讓學生盡展所長，榮幸獲施俊輝副局長為「善暖香江」一慶祝東華三院跨越155周年聯校綜藝表演主持啟動儀式。屬下多所學校學生於舞台上自信陽光、才華橫溢，體現了本院推廣全人教育的豐碩成果。此外，施俊輝副局長月內亦為「東華三院卓越德育教學獎」頒發多個獎項，參賽學校表現卓越，充分展現了其創新和教學成效，彰顯了德育入科的教學理念已深植本院屬校。

同時，2025/26學年心繫家國「樂舞呈祥」東華三院聯校綜藝匯演亦圓滿舉行，承蒙教育局副秘書長李碧茜太平紳士親臨主禮，學生以中華文化為底蘊，融合音樂、舞蹈、武術等表演形式，不僅展現了其藝術才華，更在潛移默化中深化對中華優秀文化的理解與認同。

此外，本院亦舉辦了「耆樂舊情X情繫主味間」成果展，並感謝社會福利署助理署長(安老服務)甄麗明女士主禮。該計劃透過從多元主題活動與環境優化，致力提升長者的飲食體驗，為他們締造更安心、更有尊嚴的飲食環境。

本院亦積極加強對外對內的聯繫，以鞏固及開拓更廣闊的善業網絡。月內，我們很榮幸與廣西壯族自治區民政廳廳長黃武海先生、副廳長曾凡明先生、養老服務處處長陳科吉先生、廣西大健康產業協會會長韓元利先生及顧問胡玉貞女士先後到訪，並分別前往東華三院黃祖棠護理安老院參觀交流。珠海市香洲區常委暨統戰部部長陳祥瑞女士、上海市政府港澳辦港澳處處長陳智輝先生及惠州市委常委暨統戰部部長賴建華先生亦先後到訪本院，深信此等交流互動有助促進本院服務提升與發展。

為善最樂，本月我們舉辦了「香港上海浦東聯會全力贊助：東華三院·香港黃金交易所·中國香港保齡球總會慈善保齡球大賽」，為「東華三院學生藝術及音樂教育」籌募經費，助力本地兒童及青少年發掘潛能、培養創意、建立自信和表達能力。我再次感謝社會各界及善長的鼎力支持。

本院的發源地，位於上環太平山街的廣福祠上月底亦正式透過政府刊憲獲確立為法定古蹟，成為東華三院轄下第六個法定古蹟，此舉充分肯定了該祠的歷史、文化與社會價值，標誌著本院在歷史文物保育方面再邁出重要一步。我謹代表東華三院，衷心感謝古物諮詢委員會及古物古蹟辦事處一直以來對本院保育工作的支持。

TWGHs continued to advance its services and programmes to address the needs of the people of Hong Kong. In celebration of our 155th anniversary, "T-Loft@Lau Fau", the 3rd transitional housing project funded by the Housing Bureau of the HKSAR Government and developed and operated by TWGHs, held a Move-in Worship Ceremony this month. The Event was officiated by the Hon. Winnie HO, JP, Secretary for Housing. The well-equipped project is located in a tranquil and elegant environment. It is heartening to see residents moving in gradually and beginning a new stable life. I would also like to thank the Hon. Winnie HO, JP, Secretary for Housing, for attending the "Empowering Light Living - Winter Carnival cum Poon Choi Feast", jointly organised by Yau Pok Road Light Public Housing and CLP Power Hong Kong Limited, celebrating the Chinese New Year with the residents. During the day, a fiercely contested Community Master Chef Competition crowned a local culinary champion, fully demonstrating the spirit of social inclusion while adding warmth to the festive atmosphere.

In collaboration with the HKSAR Government, we have been committed to promoting diversified social services. This month, we were honoured by the visit of Dr. the Hon. CHOI Yuk Lin, JP, Secretary for Education, together with volunteers from the Strive and Rise Programme Alumni Club, as well as volunteers led by Mr. NG Man Kit, Donald, JP, Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene, to TWGHs Siu Lam OLIVE-Courtyard and TWGHs Jockey Club Yee Lok Care and Attention Home, where they interacted with residents, bringing care and warmth during the Chinese New Year.

To promote professional growth among our staff, TWGHs held a Joint School Professional Development Day, centred on the theme "AI-Empowered Teaching and Professional Leadership: A Blueprint for the Future of Education", providing professional training to over 2,000 teaching staff members. During the Event, several professors shared their professional insights to inspire new ideas among our teaching staff. Meanwhile, TWGHs provided diverse platforms for students to showcase their talents. We were privileged to have Dr. SZE Chun Fai, Jeff, JP, Under Secretary for Education, officiate at the Kick-off Ceremony of the "Kindness and Warmth Across Hong Kong" - Joint School Fiesta in Celebration of TWGHs Beyond 155 Years, where students confidently demonstrated their talents on stage, reflecting TWGHs' achievements in promoting holistic education. In addition, during the month, Dr. SZE Chun Fai, Jeff, JP, Under Secretary for Education, presented a number of awards under the "TWGHs Award for Teaching Excellence in Moral Education". The participating schools demonstrated outstanding performances, fully showcasing their innovation and teaching effectiveness. This also reflected that the philosophy of integrating moral education into subject curricula has taken firm root in TWGHs schools.

Meanwhile, the "Love Our Home, Treasure Our Country - TWGHs Joint School Music and Dance Variety Performance 2025/26" was successfully held, with Ms. LEE Bik Sai, Ida, JP, Deputy Secretary for Education, as the Guest of Honour. Drawing inspiration from Chinese culture, students integrated music, dance, and martial arts performances, demonstrating their artistic talents while gradually deepening their understanding and appreciation of China's outstanding culture.

TWGHs also organised the "Feature Home" x "T.A.S.T.E." Showcase, officiated by Ms. YAN Lai Ming, Jenny, Assistant Director (Elderly), Social Welfare Department. Through activities with diverse themes and environmental enhancements, the programme aims to improve the dining experience of elderly people, creating a more comfortable and dignified dining environment.

We also strengthened both internal and external connections to consolidate and expand our charitable network. This recognition affirms the historical, cultural, and social significance of Kwong Fook Tsz, marking a milestone in our heritage conservation efforts. On behalf of TWGHs, I sincerely thank the Antiquities Advisory Board and the Antiquities and Monuments Office for their continued support of our conservation work.

The horse symbolises perseverance and commitment. Adhering to TWGHs tradition, I joined my fellow Board Members in visiting Wong Tai Sin Temple on Chinese New Year's Eve to pray for good fortune. During the Chinese New Year, we also held the Spring Reception, paying homage to Emperor Shen Nong with lion dance performances. My fellow Board Members also joined me in attending the Spring Receptions hosted by the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau and Hospital Authority. Recently, the TWGHs Annual General Meeting was successfully held at the Assembly Hall of Tung Wah Hospital, where the Board Members for 2026/2027 were elected.
