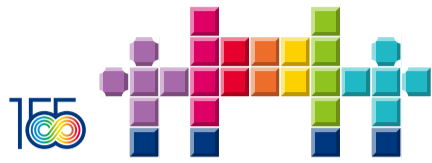




主席感言 CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE



光陰荏苒，我的主席任期即將圓滿結束。回顧過去一年，衷心感謝本院各個服務團隊的齊心協力，使多項標誌性服務及項目得以順利推展，為未來的工作奠定了堅實的基礎。在這一年，我們亦共同見證了東華三院成立155周年的重要里程碑，秉持「行善無界限」的慈善精神，凝聚社會各界力量，引領東華善業傳承下去。

過去一個月，本院喜訊連連。本年度的「東華三院跨越155周年慈善晚宴」圓滿舉行，欣蒙署理政務司司長卓永興GBS太平紳士蒞臨主禮，並榮幸獲庚申年總理楊國佳先生冠名贊助，為「A+愛童行」一站式照顧者支援服務籌募經費，以支援有自閉症譜系障礙、過度活躍或專注力不足兒童的家庭，為照顧者提供知識與精神支援，以助陪伴孩子健康成長。

此外，由東華三院與香港小輪(集團)有限公司合作推出的青年宿舍項目隆重開幕，承蒙民政及青年事務局局長麥美娟SBS太平紳士主禮，民政及青年事務局副局長梁宏正BBS太平紳士，以及民政及青年事務局青年專員陳瑞緯太平紳士亦親臨共同見證這一重要時刻。「東華·南昌匯」不僅為青年提供專屬的舒適居住空間，更致力建構有助身心發展的社交網絡，讓他們在互助互動中成長，盡展潛能。同時，我亦感謝麥局長為本院「濟公文化在香港」嘉年華主禮，促進弘揚中華傳統文化。

為提升本院的服務水平，我們積極與業界及政府部門加強聯繫。我和執行委員會成員月內榮幸與中聯辦社會工作部副部長周和先生就未來合作發展討論，藉此推動社會服務發展。而在另一場合，本院副主席曾慶業先生早前出席由勞工及福利局、社會福利署及香港社福界心連心大行動聯合主辦的「勞福局局長與社福機構『心連心』新春聚會」，並與勞工及福利局局長孫玉菡太平紳士、香港社福界心連心大行動董事會主席兼立法會議員管浩鳴SBS太平紳士、勞工及福利局常任秘書長劉焯太平紳士，以及不同社福機構代表進行了富有成效的交流。

此外，本院亦順利舉行東華三院紀錄片《泊》先導片播放暨座談會。該片以寫實紀錄形式呈現人物的生命故事，鼓勵大眾探討生死議題，以促進社區對生命課題的關注。是次活動榮幸邀得勞工及福利局副局長何啟明太平紳士蒞臨主禮，獲社會福利署副署長(行政)關淑儀太平紳士及中聯辦社會工作部李越瀚先生親臨指導，彰顯各界對推動生死教育的重視。

本院持續關顧社會不同群體的需要，早前我與董事局成員一同到訪羅湖懲教所，為一眾獲優良成績的在囚學員頒發證書，並與懲教署署長黃國興先生CSDSM會面，同時亦再度為共同成立的「東華三院正向人生教育基金」捐款，以助在囚人士重投社會，開展新生；此外，我亦榮幸與社會福利署署長杜永恒太平紳士為「壯志驕陽嘉許禮2026」主禮，並感謝多位社會福利署副署長、助理署長及地區福利專員親臨支持，表揚一眾受社會福利署署長監護或接受東華三院住宿服務的兒童和青少年的卓越表現。

教育及青年服務方面，為學生及青年人提供優質的成長空間，月內多項教育及青年發展設施相繼啟用，包括東華三院譚鑑標悅樂園開幕禮及命名禮、東蒲一宋陳碧桃創新科技工作間命名禮、東華三院許讓成樂展坊命名典禮、東華三院蔡榮星小學曹笑珍文藝創意多元發展區命名典禮、以及東華三院曾憲備小學戴永祺多功能活動中心命名典禮等。感謝社會福利署助理署長(家庭及兒童福利)鄒鳳梅女士、黃大仙民政事務專員胡鉅華太平紳士、社會福利署九龍城及油尖旺區署理福利專員范世奇先生、教育局總學校發展主任(沙田)許綺薇女士、以及教育局總學校發展主任(北區)李凱恩女士分別蒞臨主禮，為各項服務和設施賦予祝福。此外，東華三院邱金元中學和東華三院黃士心幼稚園亦在沙田民政事務專員余懷誠太平紳士和教育局總學校發展主任(觀塘)張嘉祺先生見證下，分別迎來40周年和30周年校慶。而本院的物業發展亦邁入重要進展，東華大廈順利落成及東新商業中心平頂，令人欣喜。

由東華三院主辦的「第五屆東華三院文穎怡中華文創設計獎頒獎典禮暨首五屆比賽得獎作品展覽開幕禮」亦於日前圓滿舉行，康樂及文化事務署助理署長(文博)伍志和先生、全國人大代表、立法會議員、東華三院顧問暨庚子年主席兼獎項捐款人文穎怡BBS太平紳士、立法會議員暨民政及文化體育事務委員會主席鄧家彪BBS太平紳士，以及立法會議員江旻憓小姐SBS, MH等共同見證這項推動中華文化創意設計的重要活動。

過去一年，我以「啟迪大猷，善行萬里」為管治方針，竭力開創新猷，務求為香港社會提供更多元化的服務。感謝民政事務總署助理署長黃詠慈太平紳士、民政事務總署總聯絡主任禡若翰先生出席乙巳年董事局歡送會。卸任之際，謹向特區政府、歷代前賢及顧問局成員之指導、董事局同仁與本院團隊之戮力同心，致以由衷感謝。展望未來，我深信在新任主席曾慶業先生及丙午年董事局的卓越引領下，本院將持續優化工作，續寫東華善業新章。

As time passes, my term as Chairman is drawing to a close. Looking back over the past year, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all TWGHs service teams for their concerted efforts. Their dedication has enabled the smooth implementation of a number of major services and projects, laying a solid foundation for future endeavours. During the year, we also marked the important milestone of TWGHs' 155th anniversary. Upholding the benevolent spirit of "Kindness makes a difference", we brought together support from all sectors to ensure the continued legacy of our charitable work.

Over the past month, TWGHs has received a series of encouraging news. The "TWGHs Spanning 155th Charity Dinner" was successfully held, with the Hon. CHEUK Wing Hing, GBS, JP, Acting Chief Secretary for Administration, officiating at the Event. We are also grateful for the generous support of Mr. Alexander K. K. YEUNG, Director 1980/1981, as Title Sponsor. The Event raised funds for the "A+ Love for Children" - One-stop Caregiver Support Service, which supports families of children with autism spectrum disorder, hyperactivity or attention deficit, providing caregivers with both practical knowledge and emotional support to foster their children's healthy development.

Meanwhile, "TN Residence", the youth hostel project jointly launched by TWGHs and the Hong Kong Ferry (Holdings) Co. Ltd., was officially opened. The Opening Ceremony was officiated by the Hon. MAK Mei Kuen, Alice, SBS, JP, Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs. Mr. LEUNG Wang Ching, Clarence, BBS, JP, Under Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs, and Mr. CHAN Sui Wai, Eric, JP, Commissioner for Youth of Home and Youth Affairs, also attended to witness this important occasion. "TN Residence" provides young people with comfortable and dedicated living spaces, while fostering social networks that support their physical and mental well-being, enabling them to grow through mutual support and interaction and to realise their full potential. Meanwhile, I also thank the Hon. MAK Mei Kuen, Alice, SBS, JP, Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs, for officiating at "Ji Gong Culture in Hong Kong" Carnival, which helps promote and carry forward traditional Chinese culture.

To further enhance TWGHs' service standards, we strengthened engagement with industry partners and government departments. During the month, I had the honour of joining Members of the Executive Committee in meeting Mr. ZHOU He, Deputy Director-General of the Department of Social Affairs of the LOCPG, to discuss future collaboration with a view to advancing social service development. On another occasion, our Vice-Chairman, Mr. TSENG Hing Yip, York, attended the "Connecting Hearts" Spring Gathering with Secretary for Labour and Welfare, co-organised by the Labour and Welfare Bureau, the Social Welfare Department, and the Connecting Heart. At the reception, he held fruitful exchanges with the Hon. SUN Yuk Han, Chris, JP, Secretary for Labour and Welfare, Revd Canon the Hon. KOON Ho Ming, Peter Douglas, SBS, JP, Chairman of the Connecting Hearts cum Member of the Legislative Council, Mr. LAU Yim, Alice, JP, Permanent Secretary for Labour and Welfare, and representatives from various social welfare organisations.

TWGHs also successfully held the Teaser Screening and Post-screening Panel Discussion of the documentary "Between Shores". The documentary presents individuals' life stories in a realistic manner, encouraging the public to reflect on life-and-death issues, and raising community awareness of such topics. The Event was officiated by Mr. HO Kai Ming, JP, Under Secretary for Labour and Welfare. Ms. KWAN Shuk Yee, Nancy, JP, Deputy Director of Social Welfare (Administration), and Mr. John LEE, Department of Social Affairs of the LOCPG, also attended, demonstrating the importance attached by different sectors to the promotion of life-and-death education.

TWGHs continues to respond to the needs of different groups within the community. Recently, I joined fellow Board Members in visiting Lo Wu Correctional Institution to present certificates to inmates who had achieved outstanding academic results. We also met with Mr. WONG Kwok Hing, CSDSM, Commissioner of Correctional Services. In addition, we once again contributed to the jointly established "TWGHs Positive Life Education Fund", supporting persons in custody in their reintegration into society and helping them embark on a new chapter. Meanwhile, I had the honour of officiating at the "2026 Award Presentation Ceremony for DSW Wards", together with Mr. TO Wing Hang, Edward, JP, Director of Social Welfare, with the support of several Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors, and District Social Welfare Officers of the Social Welfare Department. The Event recognised the outstanding achievements of children and young people under the guardianship of the Director of Social Welfare or receiving TWGHs residential care services.

In the area of education and youth services, TWGHs continued to provide quality spaces for students and young people to grow and develop. This month, a number of educational and youth development facilities were launched, including the Launching and Naming Ceremony for TWGHs Tam Kam Biu Jolly Playland, the Naming Ceremony for Momoko Sung Innovation and Technology Workshop Area at TWGHs TungPo, the Naming Ceremony for TWGHs Hui Yang Shing Centre for Family Wellness and Child Development, the Naming Ceremony of Tso Siu Chun Sonia Multi-Purpose Area of TWGHs Tsoi Wing Sing Primary School, and the Naming Ceremony of Tai Wing Kee Multi-Function Centre of TWGHs Tseng Hin Pei Primary School. We would like to thank Ms. CHAU Fung Mui, Wendy, Assistant Director (Family & Child Welfare), Mr. WU Kui Wah, Thomas, JP, District Officer (Wong Tai Sin), Mr. FAN Sai Ki, Dicky, Acting District Social Welfare Officer (Kowloon City/Yau Tsim Mong), Ms. HUI Yee Mei, Maria, Chief School Development Officer (Shatin), and Ms. LI Hoi Yan, Rebecca, Chief School Development Officer (North District), for officiating at these events respectively and giving their blessings to those services and facilities. At the same time, TWGHs Yow Kam Yuen College and TWGHs Wong See Sum Kindergarten celebrated their 40th and 30th anniversaries respectively, in the presence of Mr. YU Wai Shing, Frederick, JP, District Officer (Shatin), and Mr. CHEUNG Ka Ki, Edmond, Chief School Development Officer (Kwun Tong). We are also pleased to note that significant progress in our property development, with the completion of Tung Wah Tower and the topping-out of Tung Sun Commercial Centre.

Organised by TWGHs, the "Award Ceremony of TWGHs Ginny Man Chinese Cultural & Creativity Prize 2025/2026 cum Opening Ceremony of Exhibition" was successfully held. Mr. NG Chi Wo, Assistant Director (Heritage & Museums) of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, the Hon. Ginny Man, BBS, JP, Deputy to the National People's Congress, Member of the Legislative Council, Advisory Board Member of TWGHs cum Chairman 2020/2021, and the Prize's namesake, the Hon. TANG Ka Piu, BBS, JP, Member of the Legislative Council cum Chairman of Panel on Home Affairs, Culture and Sports, and the Hon. KONG Man Wai, Vivian, SBS, MH, Member of the Legislative Council, attended to witness this important event promoting Chinese cultural creative design.

Over the past year, I have adhered to the governance approach of "Spreading Kindness and Charity Beyond Miles", striving to innovate and provide more diversified services to the Hong Kong community. I am grateful to Ms. WONG Wing Chee, Chelsea, JP, Assistant Director of the Home Affairs Department, and Mr. HUEN Yeuk Hon, John, Chief Liaison Officer of the Home Affairs Department, for attending the Farewell Party for TWGHs Board of Directors 2025/2026. As I step down from my role, I would like to extend my sincere appreciation to the HKSAR Government, our predecessors and Advisory Board Members for their valuable guidance. I also extend my heartfelt thanks to my fellow Board Members and the entire TWGHs team for their dedication and unity. Looking ahead, I am confident that, under the outstanding leadership of Mr. TSENG Hing Yip, York, the new Chairman, and the Board of Directors 2026/2027, TWGHs will continue to enhance its services and write new chapters in its charitable endeavours.
