



For 155 years, TWGHs has been deeply rooted in Hong Kong, remaining steadfast in its mission to serve the community. We firmly believe improving Hong Kong's governance system is a key to promoting sustainable social development. We are pleased to see the smooth and successful conduct the Legislative Council Election in December 2025. TWGHs extends its heartfelt congratulations to 2 Advisory Board Members: The Hon. Ginny MAN, BBS, JP, Chairman 2020/2021, and the Hon. TAM Chun Kwok, Kazaf, BBS, JP, Chairman 2021/2022, as well as 2 former Board Members: the Hon. CHEN Chung Nin, Rock, SBS, JP, Director 2006/2007, and the Hon. Sunny TAN, Vice-Chairman 2016/2017, on their successful election as Legislative Council Members.

To encourage Hong Kong citizens to fulfil their civic duties, I earlier joined my fellow Board Members and senior staff in filming a video at the Assembly Hall of Tung Wah Hospital, calling on citizens to vote with a view to electing patriotic and Hong Kong-loving Legislative Council Members to jointly build a better community. On the election day, TWGHs collaborated with the Government to set up polling stations at the TWGHs Jockey Club Sunshine Complex for the Elderly and TWGHs Kap Yan Directors' College, enabling residents and other citizens living across the border to exercise their civic rights. Ms. LAM Bun Ngee, District Social Welfare Officer (Central Western, Southern and Islands), paid a visit to the TWGHs Jockey Club Sunshine Complex for the Elderly, acknowledging TWGHs' efforts in promoting community participation. Meanwhile, TWGHs introduced a series of facilitative measures at nearly 10 elderly centres and neighbourhood centres, including transport services to polling stations, volunteer assistance, and respite services, to support elderly persons and caretakers in fulfilling their civic responsibilities and participating in community affairs.

Meanwhile, the key event commemorating the 155th anniversary "TWGHs 155th Anniversary Community Fun Day", was also successfully held at TWGHs TungPo. Bringing together the Group's major service areas, the event showcased our service achievements and latest developments through a variety of presentations. We were honoured to have the Hon. SUN Yuk Han, Chris, JP, Secretary for Labour and Welfare, officiate at the Kick-off Ceremony, marking the official opening of the event. The two-day programme was enthusiastically received by the public, creating a vibrant and festive atmosphere.

In response to the continuous advancement of health technology, and with a view to further enhancing the accuracy and efficiency of pathological diagnosis, Kwong Wah Hospital has established a new Pathology Centre, becoming the first hospital in the Kowloon Central Cluster to pioneer the use of digital pathology technology. The Centre will integrate advanced artificial intelligence applications to assist in the identification of high-risk cases. Together with Dr. LEE Ha Yun, Libby, Chief Executive of the Hospital Authority, Dr. Eric CHEUNG, Cluster Chief Executive of Kowloon Central Cluster of Hospital Authority, and fellow Board Members, I officiated at the Launching Ceremony of the Centre. The Centre is expected to commence operations in the fourth quarter of 2026, providing appropriate and timely treatment to a greater number of patients.

Education and youth development are important foundations of society. To deepen exchanges and collaboration among TWGHs, the Education Bureau and District Councils, TWGHs received Ms. CHAN Wing Shiu, May, JP, Permanent Secretary for Education, Mr. LEUNG Sing Lung, Edric, JP, District Officer (Kwai Tsing) cum Chairman of the Kwai Tsing District Council, Ms. SHAM Sui Mei, Sammi, Principal Education Officer (New Territories West) of the Education Bureau, and Ms. CHAN Pui Ying, Chief School Development Officer (Tsuen Wan and Kwai Tsing) of the Education Bureau, together with 16 members of the Kwai Tsing District Council, on a visit to TWGHs Chen Zao Men College. There, teachers and students showcased the school's fruitful achievements in innovative technology learning, while guests experienced various VR interactive projects, gaining insights into TWGHs' commitment to and achievements in all-rounded education.

Organised by the Badminton Association of Hong Kong, China, and title-sponsored by Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, the "TWGHs Greater Bay Area Youth Badminton Invitational Tournament 2025" was successfully concluded. Along with Mr. TONG Wai Lun, BBS, MH, JP, Chairman of Badminton Association of Hong Kong, China, I attended the Prize Presentation Ceremony to cheer on more than 100 elite young players from 7 cities and regions in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area. Amid enthusiastic applause and cheers, the tournament promoted exchanges in badminton techniques among young people in the Greater Bay Area, while fully demonstrating the younger athletes' sporting spirit of commitment and perseverance. Meanwhile, TWGHs specially arranged for students to serve as volunteers, creating a valuable platform for interaction and inclusion among young people and thereby jointly promoting the development of the Greater Bay Area.

To promote exchanges and mutual learning between young people in Hong Kong and the Chinese Mainland, TWGHs organised the "Liaoning-Hong Kong Youth Exchange Delegation". Led by Mr. TSENG Hing Yip, York, Vice-Chairman, a total of 55 teachers and students from 5 TWGHs secondary schools visited Liaoning Province for a 5-day exchange programme to gain a deeper understanding of the country's history and culture. The students also paid a return visit to their sister school, Liaoning Province Experimental School, where they engaged in sincere interactions with local teachers and students, broadened their horizons, and forged lasting friendships.

TWGHs fully recognises the importance of sustainability. In recent days, the Group has been honoured with several major ESG awards, including accolades at the "TVB ESG Awards 2025" organised by Television Broadcasts Limited and the "ESG Achievement Awards 2024/2025" presented by the Institute of ESG & Benchmark. These honours reflect the industry's high regard for TWGHs' ESG performance. Looking ahead, the Group will continue to actively promote sustainable development and contribute to a greener future.

為鼓勵香港市民積極履行公民責任，我早前聯同董事局成員及高級職員，於東華醫院禮堂拍攝短片，呼籲市民投票，期望選出愛國愛港的立法會議員，共同建設美好社區。選舉當日，本院更配合政府，於東華三院賽馬會松朗安老綜合中心和東華三院甲寅年總理中學設立投票站，以便利院友及鄰近邊境居民行使公民權利。社會福利署中西南及離島福利專員林文儀女士亦親臨東華三院賽馬會松朗安老綜合中心視察，肯定本院推動社會參與的努力。此外，本院於近十間長者中心及鄰舍中心推出一系列便利措施，包括票站交通接送、義工協助、暫託服務等，協助長者及照顧者履行公民責任，投入社會事務。

而慶祝創院155周年重點活動「東華三院155周年社區同樂日」早前亦於東華三院東蒲圓滿舉行，活動匯聚本院各大服務範疇，以豐富多元的形式，全面展示本院服務的成果與最新發展。啟動禮榮幸邀得勞工及福利局局長孫玉菡太平紳士蒞臨主禮，為活動揭開序幕。一連兩天的活動，廣受市民歡迎，現場氣氛熱烈。

隨著醫療科技不斷進步，為進一步提升病理診斷準確度及服務效率，廣華醫院成立全新病理學中心，成為九龍中醫院聯網首間推行數位病理項目的醫院。該中心將結合最新人工智能技術，協助識別高風險個案。我和一眾董事局成員，以及醫院管理局行政總裁李夏茵醫生和醫院管理局九龍中醫院聯網總監張復熾醫生，為中心主持啟動典禮，預計中心將於2026年第四季投入運作，為更多病人提供適切治療。

教育和青年發展是社會的重要基石。為深化本院與教育局及區議會的交流合作，本院接待了教育局常任秘書長陳穎詔太平紳士、葵青民政事務專員暨葵青區議會主席梁秉龍太平紳士、教育局首席教育主任（新界西）沈穗美女士、教育局首席總學校發展主任（荃灣及葵青）陳珮盈女士，聯同16位葵青區議會議員蒞臨東華三院陳兆民中學參觀。該校師生展示了學校在創科學習方面的豐碩成果，嘉賓們亦體驗了多項VR互動項目，從中感受本院在全人發展教育的投入和成效。

由中國香港羽毛球總會有限公司主辦、東華三院冠名贊助的「東華三院大灣區青少年羽毛球邀請賽2025」圓滿舉行。我與中國香港羽毛球總會主席湯偉倫BBS,MH太平紳士出席頒獎禮，並為是次賽事匯聚粵港澳大灣區七個城市及地區逾百位青少年精英球手打氣。在熱烈掌聲和喝彩中，賽事不僅促進了大灣區青少年羽毛球技術交流，更充分展現了年輕一代球員奮力拼搏、永不言棄的體育精神。本院更特別組織了屬校學生擔任義工，為青少年搭建互動共融的寶貴平台，共同推進大灣區的發展。

此外，為推動香港與內地青年的交流互鑒，本院亦組織了「遼港青少年交流團」，由本院副主席曾慶業先生帶領屬下五所中學共55位師生前往遼寧省，展開為期五天的交流活動，深入認識祖國的歷史文化。同學們回訪姊妹學校遼寧省實驗學校，與當地師生真摯互動，同時拓寬視野，彼此建立深厚情誼。
