



主席感言 CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

本院一直致力回應基層家庭的需要，共建關愛社區。月內，「油麻地社區客廳」開幕典禮圓滿舉行，榮幸邀得署理政務司司長卓永興GBS太平紳士、勞工及福利局局長孫玉菡太平紳士、勞工及福利局常任秘書長劉焯太平紳士、社會福利署署長杜永恒太平紳士蒞臨主禮，並與星展北亞區主管及星展香港行政總裁龐華毅先生及本人一同主持開幕儀式。衷心感謝星展基金會及關愛基金的支持，使這個由東華三院營運的第二個社區客廳項目順利開展。項目專為油尖旺區的「劏房戶」而設，特別關注有兒童的家庭，為他們提供更完善的生活配套與支援。

本院多年來配合特區政府政策，並積極融入國家發展大局，竭誠為市民提供多元化服務。全國兩會早前勝利閉幕，本院亦再度舉辦「全國兩會精神分享會」，當日有超過1,600名行政總部管理層、屬校校長及服務單位主管同事透過現場及線上方式參與。本院很榮幸由立法會議員、北區區議員、新界社團聯會理事長暨本院顧問兼辛丑年主席譚鎮國議員BBS太平紳士擔任分享會的嘉賓主持，並邀得多位重量級講者，包括全國人大代表、立法會議員暨本院顧問兼庚子年主席文穎怡議員BBS太平紳士、全國人大代表朱立威議員MH、全國人大代表沈豪傑律師BBS太平紳士、全國人大代表陳曉峰議員BBS, MH太平紳士、全國政協委員暨本院顧問兼己亥年主席蔡榮星博士BBS太平紳士，以及全國政協委員馬浩文博士BBS分享真知灼見。不僅讓本院團隊更深入理解兩會精神，亦為各項服務發展注入新思維，推動本院更積極回應社會需要，持續提升服務質素。此外，配合特區政府推行的「全民國家安全教育日」，本院亦積極舉辦相關活動，包括於月內組織員工參觀「國家安全展覽廳」，提升同事對國家安全的認識與重視。

東華三院一直致力提供優質多元教育服務，欣蒙順豐香港慷慨支持，設立「東華三院順豐香港助學金計劃」，為期5年，合共捐助港幣500萬元，為本院屬下學校的基層學生提供經濟援助，同時培育更多具多元潛能的青少年人才，將來回饋社會。此外，東華三院幼稚園「童」看世界問答遊戲總決賽亦於月內順利舉行，活動旨在鼓勵幼兒探索課本以外的知識，擴闊視野，啟發思維。

月內，我亦按照傳統，與董事局成員，於清明節當天先後到東華三院廣福祠、文武廟及東華義莊拜祭先友，慎終追遠；又巡視了屬下多間服務單位，了解各單位的重點服務和最新發展，同時向前線同事表達鼓勵和支持，為這一年度的工作揭開序幕。

展望2026/2027年度，我衷心希望社會各界能繼續支持本院，我亦定將不負所望，與本院上下一心，竭誠服務社群，令善業豐茂繁盛。

The event not only enhanced our team's understanding of the spirit of the Two Sessions but also introduced new perspectives to our service development, inspiring the Group to respond more proactively to societal needs and continuously improve service quality. Furthermore, in support of the HKSAR Government's "National Security Education Day", the Group actively organised related activities, including a staff visit to the National Security Exhibition Gallery during the month, to enhance our colleagues' understanding and appreciation of national security.

I firmly believe that fostering greater exchanges with the Chinese Mainland and diverse sectors of society is instrumental in advancing our philanthropic endeavours. Recently, fellow Board Members and I visited the Hong Kong Customs Headquarters Building for a meeting with Mr. CHAN Tsz Tat, CDSM, Commissioner of Customs and Excise, and his team, further strengthening our ties and cooperation. We also participated in the 130th Anniversary celebrations of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, where we held in-depth discussions with Mainland representatives from the educational sector regarding the latest academic and cultural developments in both regions, and explored opportunities for collaboration. Additionally, we attended "The Hong Kong Jockey Club Community Day" Opening Ceremony to exchange ideas with charitable and community representatives.

TWGHs is committed to providing high-quality, diversified educational services. We are delighted to have received generous support from SFHK in launching the "TWGHs SFHK Bursaries and Community Scheme". This five-year initiative, supported by a total donation of HK\$5 million, will provide financial assistance to underprivileged students in TWGHs schools, while also nurturing more young talents with diverse aptitudes and equipping them for future contributions to society. In addition, the grand final of the TWGHs Joint Kindergartens "Every Child Explores the World" Quiz 2026 was successfully held this month. The event aims to inspire curiosity and encourage young children to explore knowledge beyond textbooks and broaden their horizons.

During the month, in keeping with a long-standing tradition, I joined fellow Board Members for the Ching Ming Festival to pay respects to the deceased at TWGHs Kwong Fook Tsz, TWGHs Man Mo Temple and the Tung Wah Coffin Home, honouring the memory of our esteemed predecessors. To mark the commencement of the new year, I also visited several of our service units to learn about our key services and the latest developments, while offering encouragement and support to our frontline colleagues.
