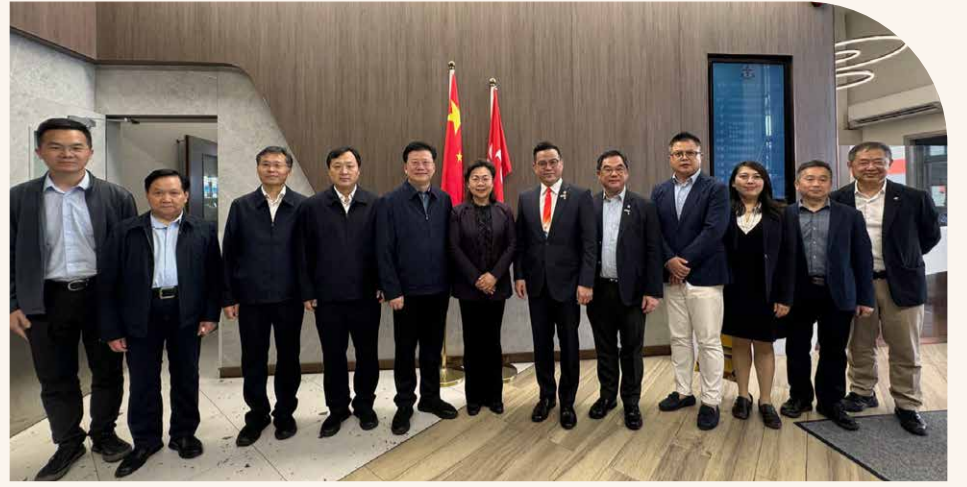

順豐香港捐款港幣500萬元成立「東華三院順豐香港助學金計劃」 為本院屬下學校的基層學生提供經濟援助 SFHK has donated HK\$ 5 million to establish the "TWGHs SFHK Bursaries and Community Scheme" in providing financial assistance to grassroots students of TWGHs

衷心感謝順豐香港慷慨支持，為本院設立「東華三院順豐香港助學金計劃」，每年捐助港幣100萬元，為期5年，合共港幣500萬元，為本院屬下54所中、小學、幼稚園及特殊學校的基層學生提供經濟援助，支援基層學生在人工智能及數碼轉型浪潮下的學習需要，紓緩家庭教育開支。順豐香港與本院多年來緊密合作，共同為社區注入正能量。當中包括順豐集團於去年大埔宏福苑事故捐贈港幣2,500萬元予本院支援受影響人士。

Thanks for the generosity of SFHK in establishing the "TWGHs SFHK Bursaries and Community Scheme". SFHK has pledged an annual donation of HK\$1 million for five consecutive years, amounting to a total of HK\$5 million. This scheme will provide financial assistance to grassroots students across 54 secondary schools, primary schools, kindergartens, and special schools of TWGHs. It aims to ease the financial burden of their families on education expenses while supporting their learning needs in the era of AI and digital transformation. SFHK has long been a close partner of TWGHs, bringing positive energy to the community together. Notably, in the Tai Po Wang Fuk Court incident last year, SF Group has donated HK\$25 million to support those affected.
