「東華・南昌匯」青年宿舍 首次傳媒導賞團 The First Media Tour of the Youth Hostel "TN Residence"

「東華·南昌匯」是由東華三院與香港小輪(集團)有限公司合作 推出的青年宿舍項目,並於六月正式投入營運及接受申請。本院首次 舉行傳媒導賞團,共15間媒體出席參觀「東華·南昌匯」的示範單位 及公共設施,並獲超過30篇媒體報導。

"TN Residence" is a youth hostel project jointly launched by TWGHs and Hong Kong Ferry (Holdings) Company Limited. It officially commenced operations and began accepting applications in June. For the first time, the Group hosted a media tour, with 15 media organisations attending to visit the Show Flat and facilities of "TN Residence", resulting in over 30 media reports.

For 8 years in a row, TWGHs has collaborated with the URA to host the Programme, aimed at deepening young people's understanding of urban renewal while cultivating their skills in problem-solving, communication, teamwork, and leadership. The Programme, themed "The District Study for Sham Shui Po", encouraged students to use geospatial data to propose urban renewal proposals for designated areas within the district.
