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Independent Assurance Report

To the Board of Directors of
Tung Wah Group of Hospitals

In accordance with our agreed terms of engagement with Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (the “Group”), we have performed an engagement on the attached statement of income and expenditure of the Group’s charitable fund-raising activities for the Charity Rides and Charity Sales 2013, held during the period from 11 November 2013 to 6 January 2014 (the “Event”).

Respective responsibilities of Directors and ourselves

The Directors of the Group are responsible for preparing the attached statement of income and expenditure in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2, setting out the gross donation raised from the Event and the expenses incurred in connection with the Event, in order to comply with the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permits No. 2013/313/1, 2013/313/2 & 2013/313/3 issued by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (“SWD”). This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the statement of income and expenditure so that it reflects the subscriptions raised and expenses incurred in connection with the Event and is free from material misstatement.

It is our responsibility to form a conclusion on the attached statement of income and expenditure, based on our engagement, and to report our conclusion to you. We do not assume responsibility towards or accept liability to any other person for the contents of this report.

Basis of conclusion

We conducted our engagement in accordance with Hong Kong Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000 “Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information” and with reference to the “Circular on Reporting on General Charitable Fund-raising Activities Covered by Public Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department (Other than Flags Days)” issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

The work undertaken in connection with this engagement is less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Furthermore, due to the nature of cash receipts and expenses relating to general charitable fund-raising activities, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the statement of income and expenditure and the books and records of the Group include all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the statement of income and expenditure. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the statement of income and expenditure prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Group’s books and records.

Our engagement includes carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquiries primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary.


Conclusion


