



TUNG WAH GROUP OF HOSPITALS 150th ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP

REGULATIONS

Name

Tung Wah Group of Hospitals 150th Anniversary Scholarship (hereafter referred to as Scholarship).

Aim

To award outstanding students of local secondary schools, upon Principals' nomination, who pursue Year 1 full-time registered undergraduate degree programme.

Number of Awards

A total of 15 scholarships will be awarded to students to subsidize their tuition fees, learning activities and living expenses. Total scholarship amount is \$200,000.

In addition, Scholarship will be awarded to students who are nominated through "Principal Special Nomination", with the total amount shall not exceed \$100,000.

Amount

Scholarship recipients shall receive a lump sum ranging from \$10,000 to \$20,000, subject to the decision of the Scholarship Management Committee. Meanwhile, they may continue to receive other scholarships at the same time and the scholarship will not decrease under such circumstances.

Criteria

1. Each local secondary school Principal may nominate 1 student of the school who attained level 5** in 2 or more subjects[#] in 2020 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination and were admitted to a full-time registered undergraduate degree programme for the 2020/21 academic year through JUPAS. Each secondary school Principal may nominate 1 more student who has overcome special adversities (e.g. disabilities and unique background) and admitted to a full-time registered undergraduate degree programme through "Principal Special Nomination".
2. Selected students should have outstanding academic performance, good character, devotion to community affairs, and active participation in extra-curricular activities and voluntary work. Priority will be given to students from families receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or receiving full-grant under the Student Financial Assistance Scheme, and to those who have experience of overcoming adversity.

Mathematics Compulsory Part and Mathematics Extended Part are counted as one subject, and attaining level 5** in either part is acceptable for the requirement of having attained level 5** in the subject. However, attaining level 5** in both the Mathematics Compulsory Part and Mathematics Extended Part can only be counted as one subject.

3. For students who are nominated through “Principal Special Nomination” can be exempted from the above lowest academic criterion in HKDSE but should have admitted to a full-time registered undergraduate degree programme through JUPAS in 2020/21.

Shortlisted students will be invited for interview. Students who are not notified by the end of January may consider their applications unsuccessful.

Announcement

Results will be announced in February / March 2021. School will be notified if the student is awarded the Scholarship.
